PROOF OF RESIDENCY DOCUMENT LIST

- An unexpired WI Driver's License or WI State ID card (or receipt)
- Other official or government-issued ID card
- Any identification card issued by an employer in the normal course of business and bearing a photo of the card holder, but not including a business card.
- Real estate tax bill or receipt (for current year or year before)
- A **Utility Bill** dated no earlier than 90 days before Election Day
- Residential Lease (not for voters who registered by mail)
- Bank statement, includes credit card statements, mortgage statements and retail credit card statements
- Paycheck or pay stub, including direct deposit documents
- A check or other document issued by a unit of government
- A University, college, or tech college ID with a photo. It must be accompanied by a fee
 receipt dated within the last 9 months or a certified housing list provided by the
 educational institution to the municipal clerk. The certified housing list does not have to
 indicate that the student is a U.S. citizen due to the 2016 One WI Institute court
 decision.
- A **letter on public or private social service agency** letterhead identifying a homeless voter and describing the individual's residence for voting purposes.
