- Televised Sanitary Sewers for 2021 Street Improvements
- Lined Sanitary Sewer in Parking Lot behind Duluth Trading.
- Designed 2021 Street, Sewer, and Water Main Improvements
- Marina
 - Constructed Improvements to Breakwall walkway (sections A-C).
- Subdivision Development; inspect infrastructure improvements:
 - Newport Vista- Reserve at High Bluff
 - Park St. Storage Condo development
