

## POLICE & FIRE COMMISSION SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Special Meeting, Monday, April 25, 2022, 6:00 p.m. Port Washington Police Dept. Community Room, 365 N. Wisconsin Street

- 1. Roll call. Present: Rick Nelson, Jim Biever, Terry Tietyen, Ed Johnson, Sarah Burdette. Also present: PWFD Captain Joe DeBoer. Meeting called to order at 6:02 p.m.
- 2. Public appearances, comments, and correspondence. None.
- 3. Review and approval of previous meeting minutes. Motion to approve the minutes of the April 11, 2022 PFC meeting by T. Tietyen, seconded by S. Burdette. Motion carried by voice vote.
- 4. Motion to convene in closed session. Motion by J. Biever, seconded by E. Johnson, to convene in closed session pursuant to Wis. Stat. 19.85(1)(c), for the purpose of considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of a public employee over which the Police & Fire Commission has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility, to-wit: interview candidates for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic.
