Whether a simultaneous meeting is occurring depends on whether the presence of one or more members of such other governmental bodies results in a quorum of such other governmental bodies and, if there is a quorum, whether any agenda items listed above involve matters within the other governmental bodies' jurisdiction. If a simultaneous meeting is occurring, no action other than information gathering will be taken at the simultaneous meeting. [State ex rel.
