SEWER TELEVISING UPDATE

The City of Port Washington's contractor will be cleaning and televising the following sanitary sewer mains during the month of December. The City does this work to assess sewer condition prior to road and sewer projects, identify locations of groundwater infiltration and inflow into the sanitary sewer, and maintain clean sewers to reduce the potential for basement backups due to the main sewer being plugged. Between contract work and sewer utility staff, the City cleans approximately 20% of the sewers annually.

During the cleaning process, you may hear a rumbling noise as the pressure jetting nozzle moves past your sanitary lateral. Although care is taken to not disturb residences, the pressure from the jetting may create bubbling and splashing in your toilets. On rare occasions, water in the basement floor drain trap may be displaced. You'll notice this if you get a sewer odor in your basement. If this happens, simply pour a gallon of water into your floor drain.
