



Trash & Recycling Weekly Collection



Trash & Recycling Information

DO

- Bag trash, not recycling
- Carts placed curbside by 6:00am
- Carts placed 4 feet apart
- Cart lid opening toward street
- During winter, clear a space at curb for cart
- Leave cart at residence when moving
- Call providers to arrange disposal of items that cannot go in trash & recycling carts
- Call Harter's (920-207-4258) if additional cart is needed-Annual rental fee applies



DO NOT

- No electronics, TV's, phones, furniture, appliances in either cart
- No yard waste in either cart
- No engine oils, anti-freeze, solvents, chemicals, hazardous materials in either cart
- No medications or medical supplies in either cart
- No propane, explosives, ammunition in either cart
- No items/bags placed outside of either cart
- No carts in roadway or on snowbanks

Accepted:

- Grass clippings
- Leaves, stumps
- Dead plants
- Weeds
- Sod
- Root balls
- Branches (AFTER Curbside Brush Collection concludes-April through early October)
- Stones/brick/broken concrete/gravel



Not Accepted:

- Treated lumber
- Wood fences
- Wood pallets
- Branches (not accepted during Curbside Brush Collection-April through early October)



Special Dumpsters For:

- Cardboard & white paper only (no Styrofoam & plastic)
- Invasive species (Garlic Mustard, Yellow Mustard, Dames Rocket, Burdock, Thistles)
- No bags in dumpsters

Accepted @ Street Yard



Hours:

- At curb by 7:00am Monday
- One-trip city-wide during the designated week



Accepted: "Woody" material trimmed from trees/shrubs, 8-inch diameter or less



Not Accepted - take to Street Yard

- Brush larger than 8-inch diameter
- Logs/stumps
- Grass clippings/Yard waste
- Plant debris/leaves/pinecones
- Flowers/vegetables/pumpkins/corn stalks



How To Stack Brush:

- Place near curb, in parkway area
- Do not place in street
- Cut ends facing street
- Neat & manageable piles not exceeding 3 feet height limit
- Small twigs & brush-place in an open container for pickup (no bags)



Special Notes:

- Narrow curb (parkway area)-place in neat piles behind sidewalk (in yard)
- Alley pickup not available-call 262-284-2600 for pickup
- Hauling away-Brush piles 5-feet high & 15feet long can be "hauled away" at a \$60.00 charge rate.

IMPORTANT SEASONAL NOTES



Grass Clippings

DO NOT mow or blow grass clippings into street!

- Slippery for pedestrians, cyclists & vehicles
- Negatively affects water supplies
- Deprives lawn of nutrients
- Blowing dangerous debris at pedestrians, cyclists & vehicles
- Take grass clippings to **Street Yard**



Fall Leaf Collection

October 1 - November 24, 2024

- Rake leaves (only) to the curb by Monday at 7:00am
- One trip made city-wide weekly for pick-up
- Leave are accepted at <u>Street Yard</u> also



Mulch/Dirt @ Street Yard

- Mulch & dirt OK to take from the piles
- Mulch (old, bark, dyed) OK to dump on pile



Holiday Tree Collection

January 2025

- Natural trees-place at curb (no plastic bags)
- Pick-up several times during January
- Remove from stand & lights & ornaments

The City of Port Washington issues water/sewer bills every other month. Typically, bills are issued the first week of the month following the end of the billing period. The billing periods are listed below:

- January/February
- March/April
- May/June
- July/August
- September/October
- November/December
