The 2022 boating season saw a decline in boats launching as well as a decline in transient traffic. This was due in part by the rising fuel costs. Most fishermen were only going out if the fishing was good and you didn't see as many boaters just taking an afternoon or weekend cruise on beautiful day. Sadly, we also had several of our yearly groups from across the lake cancel reservations for weekend stays here at the marina due to the high fuel costs. However, what we did find is that we had a lot of our transient guests taking advantage of our weekly rates, staying here longer rather than spending a few days here and a few days at another Marina. We also had some saving grace in fall with the amount of "Great Looper" traffic we had fueling up here and spending a few nights up to a week or two before making their way to Chicago and heading south for the winter.

The fish cleaning station was relocated spring of 2022. The change in location ended up being a smooth transition. The GLSF Ozaukee Chapter donated (10) dock carts that the fishermen can use to transport their coolers from their vehicles to the station. The Marina did some minor adjustments to the hoses and tables to make it more convenient for cleaning fish. The fishermen seem very pleased with the new station and location.

In the early spring of 2022, we learned that insurance was no longer going to cover the aging underground gasoline and diesel storage tanks. Looking into replacing the tanks was an ongoing process all year. The hope is to have them installed in the spring of 2023.

The Marina received the go ahead to move forward with the Pier 5 addition from the Army Corps of Engineers and the WIDNR. The dredging for the addition took place and was completed in December 2022. The new slips should arrive and be installed in spring of 2023 welcoming (14) new tenants to the Marina.

One of our goals every year is to achieve the "Elite Boaters Choice" award from Marinas.com which is the highest award given based on customer reviews. With the help of all our employees who did an excellent job this last year I am proud to say that for the third year in a row, we were awarded with the "Elite Boaters Choice" Award in December of 2022. Thank you to all our wonderful customers for their support!

- The Marina received approval from the Army Corps of Engineers and the WI DNR to move forward with dredging north of Pier 5

The Marina continues to be booked with transient guests practically every weekend throughout the summer. The Marina has become the "Must Stop" location for Loopers (boaters doing the great loop), which keeps the Marina busy well into the fall season.
- Marina staff completed the finishing touches to the new fish cleaning station by installing the Port Washington Welcome Sign that holds the fish scale and hooks. New hoses were installed, and other minor electrical upgrades were made based on customer needs and wants.
- (4) New picnic tables were purchased and installed in the new picnic area north of the North Building, along with nautical decorations. Giving it a warm welcoming atmosphere.
- Marina personnel continue to replace deteriorating boards along the North Slip as needed.
- The Marina was chosen by the Wisconsin Clean Marina program to participate in a promotional video on proper fueling procedures and best practices as they were impressed with our operation during our last Clean Marina Recertification process.
- Increased employee training on safety and boating protocols
- Upgraded Marina software with all contracts and reservations going through the online Dockwa portal, improving
 efficiency in the Marina office.

(RELOCATED TO TRAILER PARKING LOT SPRING 2022)









- The fish cleaning station was moved from the north end of the Marina to its current location in the vehicle with trailer parking lot spring of 2022
- Ansay Development built the fish cleaning station with a clean, bright, open-air look, installing the blue metal roof to match the look of the Marina Control Building
- The fish cleaning station opened for public use the end May 2022
- Some modifications were done by marina staff to make the station more user friendly
- (10) dock carts were donated by the Great Lakes Sport Fishermen-OZ Chapter to make it convenient for fishermen to take their coolers from their vehicles to the station
- July 2022, Marina staff, with the help of streets, installed the Port Washington sign that holds the hooks to hang fish as well as the fish scale for weighing fish, making the project complete.


GOALS TO WORK TOWARDS IN 2023 ARE AS FOLLOWS



- Install central air to our North Building, making it a more comfortable environment during the hot summer months for our tenants and guests utilizing the private restrooms, showers, laundry facilities and boater's lounge.
- Replace the gasoline and diesel Underground Storage Tanks.
- Continue to upgrade the Marina software based on the latest technology.
- The Marina will continue to operate as a Certified Clean Marina.
- Strive to achieve the Elite Fleet Boαter's Choice award from Marinas.com


MARINA TRANSIENT GUEST SURVEY RESULTS




















MARINA END OF SEASON TENANT SURVEY RESULTS
