Completed Bike Trail Connection to Breakwater Gateway (Stewardship program)



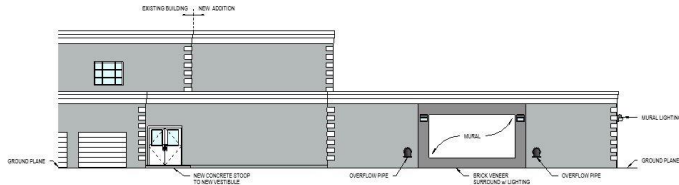

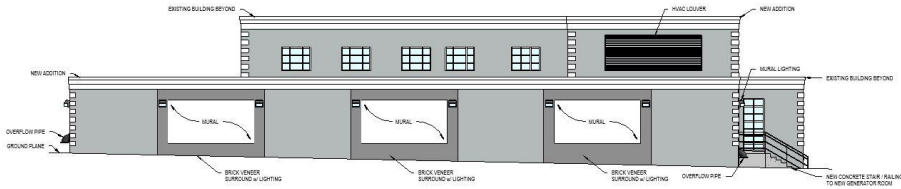

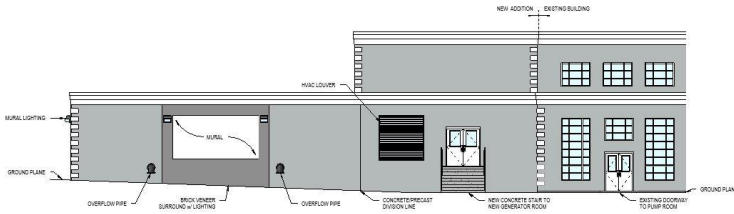

EXTERIOR ELEVATION - NEW CONSTRUCTION - WEST



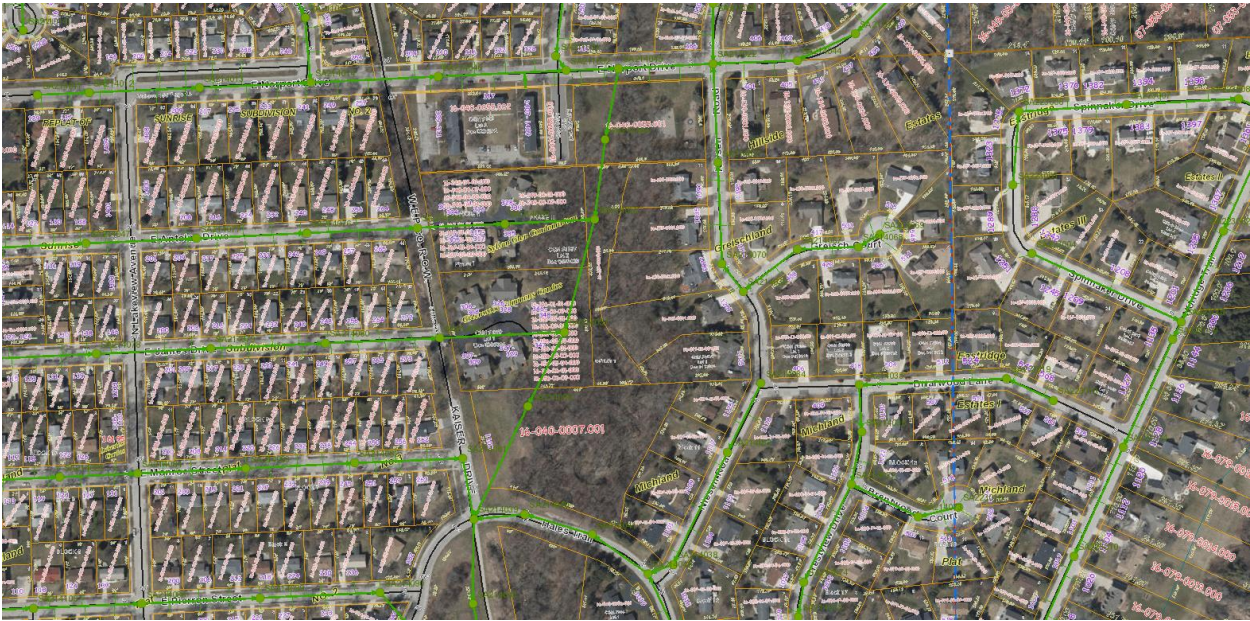
EXTERIOR ELEVATION - NEW CONSTRUCTION - SOUTH
