OPENING CEREMONY WALK/SOCIAL

BOCCE BALL

Teams (4 per team) will be assigned; two of each team at opposite ends of the court. Teams stay together. Starting side determined by a coin toss. Player from starting team tosses out the white ball;

the same player tosses out first two balls. The opposing side throws two balls and continues to switch after two balls are thrown and all balls are exhausted. One point is awarded for each ball closer to the white ball than the opposing team's best ball. Elimination games are played to 11 points; semi-final game – 11 pts.; final game – 15 pts. House rules apply.
