The 2023 boating season saw an increase in boats launching thanks to great weather and fishing late spring through most of the summer months. We can't thank all our customers enough for their patience and understanding during the months of May through July while the Underground Storage Tanks were being replaced. Parking was a bit of a mess in the trailer lot at times during construction and there were few complaints.

Transient traffic remained steady through most of the summer. Several guests took advantage of our weekly rates and monthly rates, staying here longer rather than spending a few days here and a few days at another Marina. The Marina also had a major increase in small fishing boats staying here for several nights to a week or even longer as McKinley Marina's parking lots were being redone leaving them with limited parking available. Those that normally fished out of Milwaukee came to Port instead which was fantastic for us.

Late summer and into fall brought a lot of wind, warm water, and poor lake conditions. We took a big hit in August as several of our large groups out of Michigan had to cancel as the lake didn't allow for safe travel. Fall fishing for the smaller boats was almost non-existent due to the warm water in the harbor. Larger vessels could get out on the lake and search for the cold water if it wasn't too rough. The fish were not in the harbor either and when they were, they weren't biting. There really wasn't any shore fishing to speak of which was quite surprising as it has been a booming industry for us the last couple of years. Looper traffic was also affected by the poor lake conditions in fall. Many Loopers bypassed Port Washington to get closer to Chicago when the weather allowed. However, we did have a couple Looper's that stayed a month or more waiting for their turn to go through the locks.

This year saw several upgrades and additions from the Underground Storage Tank replacements and the Pier 5 addition to the central air in the North Building providing a more comfortable experience for our tenants and guests during the hot summer months. Additional security cameras were also installed giving our customers that extra sense of security while they are here or away from their boats.

One of our goals every year is to achieve the "Elite Boaters Choice" award from Marinas.com which is the highest award given based on customer reviews. With the help of all our employees who did an excellent job this last year I am proud to say that for the fourth year in a row, we were awarded with the "Elite Boaters Choice" Award in December of 2023. Thank you to all our wonderful customers for their support!

2023 ACHIEVEMENTS

- Installed (7) finger piers on the north side of Pier 5 adding an additional (14) 30' slips to the Marina
- New Underground Storage Gasoline and Diesel tanks were installed with all new lines and piping from the tanks to the Fuel Pier
- A new EVO 600 Automatic Tank Gauge monitoring system for the new fuel tanks was installed
- A new furnace/central air unit was installed at the North Building and the Marina Control Building
- Three additional security cameras were installed increasing security measures around the North Slip and trailer parking lot . A new PTZ camera was installed on the roof of the Control Building that may be moved to monitor areas of concern.
- Purchased (4) new golf carts replacing the older used golf carts
- Continue to upgrade Marina software based on latest technology
- The Marina proudly achieved the "Elite Boater's Choice" award from Marinas.com based on customer reviews of our facilities and over-all Marina operations and performance. The Elite Fleet is the highest award given by Marinas.com. Thanks to the Port Washington Marina's reputation as one of the best Marinas on the Western Shores of Lake Michigan, the Marina is once again filled to over 100% capacity boasting a healthy waiting list of boaters wanting to call Port Washington Marina home, proving that Port Washington continues to be a highly sought after Destination Marina. The Marina continues to be booked with transient guests practically every weekend throughout the summer. The Marina has become the "Must Stop" location for Loopers (boaters doing the great loop), which keeps the Marina busy well into the fall season.
- Marina personnel continue to replace deteriorating boards along the North Slip as needed.
- Continued to operate as a Certified Clean Marina following the best practices set forth by the Wisconsin Clean Marina
 Program
- Increased starting wages of Marina staff to retain existing staff and align with industry standards when hiring new staff

PIER 5 ADDITION (7) FINGER PIERS-(14) TOTAL SLIPS







- Dredging of the north side of Pier 5 commenced on November 30th2022, and was completed by December 15^{th,} 2022 by McMullen & Pitz
- The (7) finger piers arrived early April 2023 from Meeco-Sullivan out of Oklahoma and were unloaded and placed in the Marina lot by Matt from the Streets Division
- Marina staff attached the fillets while in the parking lot, preparing the slips for installation prior to launching
- Marina staff launched and installed the slips finishing the installation by Thursday May 25th

PIER 5 ADDITION CONTINUED





- Electrical and water hookups were installed, as well as dock boxes and hose hangers
- Gary Fischer from the Streets Division made the reflective number plates for the finger piers that were installed by Marina staff
- The first week of June slips were rented out for the season

UNDERGROUND GASOLINE AND DIESEL STORAGE TANK REPLACEMENT







- Interstate Pump & Tank was awarded the contract for the Underground Storage Tanks
- May 8th they broke ground
- May 10th the Underground Diesel and Gasoline Storage tanks were delivered and placed in the ground
- During the month of May and into June all new underground piping from the fuel tanks to the water's edge under the fuel dock was installed
- Friday June 30th the state granted the marina's permit to operate the new tanks

UNDERGROUND GASOLINE AND DIESEL STORAGE TANK REPLACEMENT CONTINUED









- A new Automatic Tank Gauge system was installed to monitor the UST's and the lines. This system monitors the sensors for the sumps, lines for any leaks, tanks for any leaks, fuel in the tanks, the pressure in the system, etc.
- The old Underground Storage Tanks were filled with slurry and officially abandoned after borings showed no sign of contamination in the area. Everything was backfilled and concrete was poured in July
- The city Streets Division cut out and replaced the damaged black top and line painted to complete the project in August

GOALS TO WORK TOWARDS IN 2024 ARE AS FOLLOWS


- Add an additional (4) security cameras focusing on areas not covered by previously installed cameras
- Upgrade all Wi-Fi radios around the Marina utilizing the latest technology
- Reseal and stripe the vehicle with trailer lot (M-4) and the tenant and metered lots (M-5 and M-6) providing clear parking guidelines and improved parking experience
- Explore installing permeable pavers around the fish cleaning station to reduce standing water following Wisconsin Clean Marina best practices for storm water management and green infrastructure. Apply for related grants to complete the project
- Apply for a grant to replace existing dockside pump out system
- Repair existing potholes in Marina parking lots
- Continue to upgrade the Marina software based on the latest technology.
- Continue to operate as a Certified Clean Marina.
- Strive to achieve the *Elite Fleet Boater's Choice* award from Marinas.com
- Strive to offer the best customer service experience for all Marina tenants and guests
- Continue to promote the Port Washington Marina as a Destination Marina and capitalize on the Marina's proximity to the downtown area and all it has to offer (i.e., restaurants, bars, shops, parks, beaches, and the Interurban Trail to name a few).


MARINA TRANSIENT GUEST SURVEY RESULTS 2023




MARINA END OF SEASON TENANT SURVEY RESULTS 2023


