

## POLICE & FIRE COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

Meeting, Monday, December 13, 2021, 6:00 p.m. Port Washington Police Dept. Community Room, 365 N. Wisconsin Street

- 1. Roll call. Present: Rick Nelson, Jim Biever, Edward Johnson, Terry Tietyen, Sarah Burdette. Also present: Fire Chief Mark Mitchell, Police Chief Kevin Hingiss, Alderperson Dan Benning. From the Ozaukee Press, Kris Halbig-Ziehm. Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.
- 2. Public Appearances, Comments, and Correspondence. Alderperson Benning thanked each of the Chiefs for their efforts in supporting the recent Christmas parade.
- 3. Review of Previous Meeting Minutes. Motion to approve the minutes of the November 8, 2021 PFC meeting by T. Tietyen, seconded by J. Biever. Motion carried on voice vote.

## POLICE DEPARTMENT

- 1. Review of bills November 2021. Chief Hingiss indicated that some of the AT&T bills may have been overpaid. That is being investigated. He also highlighted the use of education reimbursement funds by Lt. Nye.
- 2. Review of budget November 2021. The budget was reviewed.
- 3. Municipal Court statement October 2021. The statement was reviewed.
- 4. Calls for Service November 2021. Calls reviewed.
- 5. Update on Personnel. Chieif Hingiss informed the Commission that Colin Dunn, the newest officer, recently completed Academy training at WCTC. As of December 13<sup>th</sup>, he had begun his field training. A conditional offer was made to a potential officer. If all works out, that officer would start field training on 1/4/22.
- 6. Other business as permitted by law: Review meeting schedule and calendar matters; referrals to future meetings. No further business.

## AMBULANCE DEPARTMENT

- 1. Review and discussion November 2021 Ambulance Invoices. The invoices were reviewed.
- 2. Review and discussion Ambulance Budget through 11/30/2021. The budget was reviewed.
- 3. Review and discussion November 2021 Ambulance Calls, both Transports and Non-Transports. Chief Mitchell related that we are on a trajectory of over 1,600 calls for the year. Beginning next month, the monthly reports will indicate when a call was covered by another department.
- 4. Review and discussion November 2021 Paramedic Intercepts. Chief Mitchell answered questions related to paramedic intercepts.
- 5. Discussion and action to hire Taylor Green as a part-time EMT-Paramedic. T. Tietyen made a motion to hire Taylor Green as a part-time paid on premise EMT-Paramedic, pending a successful physical. J. Biever seconded. Motion carried on voice vote.
- 6. Other business as permitted by law: Review meeting schedule and calendar matters; referrals to future meetings. The next meeting of the Police & Fire Commission was scheduled for January 10, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.

## FIRE DEPARTMENT

- 1. Review and discussion November 2021 Fire Invoices. The invoices were reviewed.
- 2. Review and discussion Fire Budget through 11/30/2021. The budget was reviewed.
- 3. Review and discussion November 2021 Fire Calls. Chief Mitchell noted that this is the first year that there have been over 300 fire calls. There was a discussion about false alarms.

- 4. Fire Chief's report a. Disposition of department's van. Chief Mitchell indicated the van had been donated to Rawhide Boys Ranch.
  - b. Disposition of former Ambulance 452. Chief Mitchell related that Moraine Park Technical College is moving forward with the purchase of the ambulance.
- 5. Motion to go into closed session, authorized as noted by Wisconsin Statutes for: "considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation of a public employee," WS 19.85 (1)(c), regarding employees' compensation. To wit: Hiring a Firefighter/Paramedic to fill the second full-time budgeted position in 2022. Chair Nelson made motion to convene in closed session. E. Johnson seconded. Roll call vote was unanimous.
- 6. Reconvene in open session. T. Tietyen moved to reconvene into open session. J. Biever seconded. Roll call vote was unanimous.
- 7. Action on closed session matters, if any. J. Beiever moved that Chief Mitchell be granted authority to hire Sam Lorge as a full-time Firefighter/Paramedic. T. Tietyen seconded. Motion carried on voice vote.
- 8. Other business as permitted by law: Review meeting schedule and calendar matters; referrals to future meetings.

Adjournment. Motion by E. Johnson, seconded by T. Tietyen, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried on voice vote. Chair Nelson adjourned the meeting at 7:28 p.m.
