CITY OF PORT WASHINGTON, WISCONSIN ORDINANCE NO. 2017-5

Relating to Membership of the Design Review Board

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 20.30.050 A. of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Port Washington, relating to membership of the Design Review Board, is amended to read as follows:

A. Membership. The Design Review Board shall consist of five (5) members, as follows: the City Engineer; one representative from the Police or Fire Department appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Plan Commission; and three persons appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the Common Council, not more than one of whom may be a non-resident of the City. Of the three persons appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the Common Council, one should be a graduate architect in the state of Wisconsin, the other should have design, development or construction training or experience, and each of said three persons shall serve a term of three years. The members of the Board shall, at its regular May meeting, elect one member to act as Chairperson for a term of one year, or until a successor is duly elected. The Chairperson shall preside over all the meetings of the Board. In the event of the Chairperson's absence, the Board members who are present shall select a member to preside over the meeting. The Director of Planning and Development shall be responsible for processing applications, agendas and minutes for the Board, and for presenting the recommendations of the Board to the Plan Commission.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
